Journey's End Refugee Services announces the hiring of Al Dirschberger, Ph.D., LCSW as the agency's Executive Director. Dr. Dirschberger will begin his new role on January 20, 2015.

Dr. Dirschberger graduated cum laude from Medaille College and went on to obtain his Masters Degree in Social Work and Ph.D. in Social Welfare from the State University of New York at Buffalo. Dr. Dirschberger joins Journey's End Refugee Services after 28 successful years with a well-regarded local child and family services organization, Gateway Longview, Inc.

As Vice President at Gateway Longview since July 2002, he was highly effective in managing a large staff; collaborating with governmental officials and agencies in order to deliver the best managed care and services to residents and their families; engaging in community outreach; securing large grants for the organization; managing its \$10,000,000 Residential Services budget; and working closely with their Board of Directors to ensure the agency's continued success. In addition to his many duties at Gateway Longview, he is also a tenured professor at Erie Community College, in its Social Sciences Department, and an adjunct professor of Research Methods at Daemen College.
